

## Preparing the final version of your manuscript for KKA-PCC'2020

1. Please concern seriously the reviews and improve the paper according to the remarks and comments there.
2. Do not change the title and authors, unless it is obviously necessary (typos or mistakes). Please place an envelope icon (or any other pointer) next to the name of the corresponding author, whose email address is mandatory. It will be used by the publisher at the final proofreading stage.
3. Prepare the final version using Word <ftp://ftp.springernature.com/cs-proceeding/lnncs/word/splnproc1703.zip> or LaTeX <ftp://ftp.springernature.com/cs-proceeding/svproc/templates/ProcSci TeX.zip> templates from <https://www.springer.com/us/authors-editors/conference-proceedings/conference-proceedings-guidelines> . Make sure that the whole paper, including headings, figures, formulae, bibliography, is prepared strictly according to the formatting rules given there. Papers violating the rules will be rejected by the publisher.
4. Make sure that all figures are readable in black-white print.
5. Proofread your paper carefully.
6. Collect all files:
  - all source files (LaTeX files with all the associated style files, special fonts and eps files, or Word or rtf files),
  - the final pdf of the paper,
  - your signed copyright form (<http://kka.p.lodz.pl/assets/Springer-Consent-to-Publish.doc>) as a scanned PDF, your signed registration form (<http://kka.p.lodz.pl/assets/kka2020-registration form.pdf>) as a scanned PDF,and pack the files into a zip archive giving it the name CONTRIBUTION-NUMBER\_AUTHOR-NAME. **\*IF THE ARCHIVE CONTAINS \*.docm FILE, SECURE IT WITH PASSWORD 'kka'**
7. E-mail the archive as soon as possible, but not later than **23.03.2020** to [kka@info.p.lodz.pl](mailto:kka@info.p.lodz.pl).
8. If your paper was accepted for the lecture session, prepare your slides remembering that you will have 10-15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion.
9. If your paper was accepted for a poster session, prepare your A1 poster according to the common standards.
